- Lyrical Math: A creative program that combines music, rhythm, and math concepts to teach multiplication and vocabulary in an engaging way.
- **Beyond Those Bars:** Students explored creativity and teamwork by writing and editing rap lyrics using computer software.

- **Social Emotional Learning:** Activities designed to promote teamwork, self-awareness, and respect for others through practices like Tech Zen Mindfulness, Flyogi Yoga, and collaborative exercises.
- **Literacy:** Interactive lessons that strengthen reading and writing skills using engaging, hands-on approaches.
- Art & STEAM Learning: Creative projects, such as Lyrical, Crystal Burnett Dance Program, Exquisite Cupcake Design, and Math, that encourage artistic expression and imaginative thinking.
- Mentorships: Building positive relationships with staff and peers to foster growth and development. Key initiatives include the Sankofa Rites of Passage, Cultural Restoration Project, and Program and Project Ready with the Wilmington Delaware Urban League.
