### School Report by Dr. Principal EL

Dr. Principal EL reported, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Trimester ends on Friday, March 7<sup>th</sup>. Report Cards will be distributed to parents during the week of March 24<sup>th</sup>. Spring Break begins on Thursday, April 17<sup>th</sup> and school resumes on Monday.

Our Instructional Leadership Team hosted Family Math Night on Thursday, February 27<sup>th</sup>. We had a great turnout of families who learned so much—it was an amazing time! Great way to end BHM!

We have had good attendance at each Saturday Academy session, and we are continuing to recruit even more students to attend. There is one (1) remaining Saturday Academy session scheduled.

We are in the beginning stages of planning for Teacher and Staff Appreciation Week, which will be held Monday, May 5<sup>th</sup> to Friday, May 9<sup>th</sup>.

We are preparing for our Smarter Balance (SBAC) Math and ELA state testing for grades 3-8 which will begin the week of May 5<sup>th</sup>. DeSSA Science (Grades 5 and 8) and Social Studies (Grades 4-8) state testing will begin the week of May 19<sup>th</sup>.

We are in full "Gala Mode' for the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration. We need everyone to start sending Gala ticket and sponsorship info emails to their contacts.

The motors and pumps on the boilers have been rebuilt and replaced. We have had no heating issues this season. Furniture for the modular has arrived (tables and chairs) and Smart Boards.

## School Financials by P. Winder

P. Winder reported, in revenues we have \$12.2M. In February we received the last of the unit count funds that was to true up everything, approximately \$40,000. From here on out there are no more unit count funds or local funds to receive, only Federal Grant Funds. We do have \$3.7M of cash and we will receive Federal Grant monies as we spend those funds.

Our expenses right now are \$8.5M and cash of \$3.7M.
