#### School Report by Principal EL

Principal EL congratulated all students for completing the READBowl and earning some state titles! READBowl is a National Reading Competition to promote students reading. TECS won three out of the four conferences for the READBowl State Championship!

As part of the DDOE required school improvement planning process, we will be receiving a very large grant. The plan is required based on our SBAC test data. We are completing the plan and will submit the final version to the state by the end of March.

All teachers and staff are participating in our last professional development on the Delaware Teacher Growth and Support System (DTOSS.) This is the state's new teacher evaluation system. The PD provided by Research for Better Teaching (RBT) was held on Friday, February 17<sup>th</sup> and is extremely beneficial to the teaching and learning happening at TECS.

Sobieski performed a test of all of our fire and smoke alarms and we passed with no issues at all.

Jesse replaced the counter in the girls' bathroom. New water heater being installed in kindergarten.
