School Report by Dr. Principal EL

Dr. Principal EL reported Thanksgiving break begins on Tuesday, November 26th.

We will officially change over to heat from A/C for the winter this week.

School Financials by P. Winder

P. Winder reported, as of October 31st \$6.3M has been received in revenue. This is primarily made up of the first payment of the Unit Count in the amount of \$3.3M. We did receive all of the first 35% payments on all local funds on all districts. That is approximately \$1.3M collected year to date. The majority of the rest would be the \$1M received in federal funds.

Year to date as of October 31 we have spent \$3.8M. The majority of that is salary and other employment costs. We have \$1.1M in debt services which is pretty much a fixed cost and payments to vendors such as Blackstar, the auditors, professional services and things like that. At this point we are expecting to end the year with \$16,000.
